Your offer of access to general records per the terms and conditions in the Freedom of Information Act is hereby accepted. The order is below.

Ordered Records:

All studies in the possession/custody/control of Robert F. Kennedy Jr. and/or the Department of Health and Human Services Office of the Secretary, **authored by anyone, anywhere, ever:**

1. - that **scientifically prove/provide evidence of the existence of the alleged measles virus or SARS-COV-2** (showing that the alleged particles exist, invade and replicate in "host" cells and cause the illness/symptoms that they are alleged to cause), or
2. - (if no records exist for #1) that at least describe the **purification of particles that are alleged to be either of said alleged viruses** directly from bodily fluid/tissue/excrement of so-called "hosts", with purification confirmed via imaging, or
3. - **wherein the purported "genome" of either alleged virus was found intact** in the bodily fluid/tissue/excrement of a "host" (as opposed to fabricated in silico aka a mere made-up computer model), or
4. - that **scientifically demonstrate contagion of the illness / symptoms** that are alleged to be caused by either alleged virus, or
5. - wherein **the sensitivity, specificity, positive predictive value, negative predictive value or overall accuracy of any test** alleged to relate to either alleged virus was assessed in a valid manner (logically, this would require the relevant alleged virus to first be proven to exist), or
6. - wherein **"measles" or "covid-19" was shown to be a distinct illness** that can be clearly differentiated from other health conditions.

This acknowledges receipt of your April 13, 2025, Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request, submitted to the Department of Health and Human Services (HHS), FOI/Privacy Acts Division concerning: "...All studies in the possession/custody/control of Robert F. Kennedy Jr. and/or the Department of Health and Human Services Office of the Secretary, authored by anyone, anywhere, ever: 1) that scientifically prove/provide evidence of the existence of the alleged measles virus or SARS-COV-2 (showing that the alleged particles exist, invade and replicate in "host" cells and cause the illness/symptoms that they are alleged to cause), or 2(if no records exist for #1) that at least describe the purification of particles that are alleged to be either of said alleged viruses directly from bodily fluid/tissue/excrement of so-called "hosts", with purification confirmed via imaging, or 3) wherein the purported "genome" of either alleged virus was found intact in the bodily.."

We received your request on April 13, 2025.

Because you seek records which require a search in another office, "unusual circumstances" apply to your request, automatically extending the time limit to respond to your request for ten additional days. See 5 U.S.C. 552 § (a)(6)(B)(i)-(iii) (2012 & Supp. V. 2017). The actual time needed to process your request will depend on the complexity of our records search and on the volume and complexity of any material located. For your information, this Office assigns incoming requests to one of three tracks: simple, complex, or expedited. Each request is then handled on a first-in, first-out basis in relation to other requests in the same track. Our current workload is approximately 7000 cases.
