Pursuant to paragraphs 9(1)(a), (b) and (c) of the Act (copy attached), an extension of 90 days is required beyond the statutory 30-day limit allowed for the processing of your request as meeting the original time limit would unreasonably interfere with the operations of the Department. Consultations with other government institutions and notifications to third parties pursuant to subsection 27(1) of the Act are also required and cannot reasonably be completed within the original time limit.

Access to Information Act

EXTENSION OF TIME LIMITS

9.(1) The head of a government institution may extend the time limit set out in section 7 or subsection 8(1) in respect of a request under this Act for a reasonable period of time, having regard to the circumstances, if

(a) the request is for a large number of records or necessitates a search through a large number of records and meeting the original time limit would unreasonably interfere with the operations of the government institution,

(b) consultations are necessary to comply with the request that cannot reasonably be completed within the original time limit, or

(c) notice of the request is given pursuant to subsection 27(1)

by giving notice of the extension and, in the circumstances set out in paragraph (a) or (b), the length of the extension, to the person who made the request within thirty days after the request is received, which notice shall contain a statement that the person has a right to make a complaint to the Information Commissioner about the extension.

Notice of extension to Information Commissioner

(2) Where the head of a government institution extends a time limit under subsection (1) for more than thirty days, the head of the institution shall give notice of the extension to the Information Commissioner at the same time as notice is given under subsection (1).

Good day Susan Drysdale who acts as Director, Access to Information and Privacy, Environment and Climate Change Canada.

Thank you for your letter dated May 29, 2025 advising of an extension of 90 days beyond the statutory 30-day limit allowed for the processing of the order.

I hope that searching for studies that scientifically prove/provide evidence of the existence of the imagined "avian influenza virus", or that scientifically demonstrate contagion of the non-specific "bird flu" illness / symptoms, or that at least show the claimed "viral genome" being found intact in the bodily fluid/tissue/excrement of a "host", or that at minimum describe particles suspected of being said alleged virus being found and purified from a "host" (so that valid sequencing, characterization and controlled experiments could later take place) - which the "experts" at Canadian Food Inspection Agency, Agriculture and Agri-Food Canada, Public Health Agency of Canada, the U.S. Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, the U.S. Food and Drug Administration, the U.S. Department of Agriculture and many other institutions were officially unable to provide or cite (as shown here: <https://christinemasseyfois.substack.com/p/dont-fall-for-the-avian-influenza>) - has not been too distressing or embarrassing for you and your colleagues.

This purpose of this message is to point out that the 90 days have long since passed and you are in breach of contract.

However I am pleased to advise that you have been granted an additional 24 hours from the sending of this email (October 9, 2025, 2:07 pm) to respond, at which time I will go public with your response or non-response, as the case may be.
