Dear Carlos Gonalo das Neves, Chief Scientist, European Food Safety Authority,

I am writing to you with a challenge and will be publishing your response or lack thereof, in the public interest.

I will wait until at least March 16, 2026 before publishing your response or lack thereof. If you need more time to respond, please let me know.

The challenge is for you (or anyone else at the European Food Safety Authority to whom you may wish to delegate), to provide or cite studies authored by anyone, anywhere, ever:

1. - that scientifically prove or provide evidence of the existence of the alleged goatpox virus, sheeppox virus, lumpy skin disease virus or any other alleged virus of the Poxviridae family (at minimum showing that the alleged particles with the claimed "genome" and proteins exist and that they cause the illness/symptoms that they are alleged to cause),

(Note: Scientific proof/evidence is not opinions, speculation, declarations, review papers or descriptive studies. Scientific evidence requires use of the scientific method to test falsifiable hypotheses through valid, rigorous, repeatable controlled experiments.)

2. - or (if no records exist for #1) that at least describe the purification of particles that are claimed to be any of these alleged viruses, directly from bodily fluid/tissue/excrement of so-called "hosts" (without adding any sources of genetic material or proteins), with purification confirmed via EM imaging.

(Purify = separate from everything else in the clinical sample. I am aware that according to virus dogma a virus requires host cells in order to replicate. I am not seeking records that describe a virus replicating without host cells, or that describe a suspected virus floating in a vacuum or a strict fulfillment of Koch's Postulates. I am not seeking private patient records. I am simply seeking records that describe purification: separation from everything else in the "host" sample.)

3. - or, wherein the purported "genome" of any of these alleged viruses was found intact in the bodily fluid/tissue of a "host" (as opposed to fabricated in silico, aka computer modelled),

4. - or, that scientifically demonstrate transmission / contagion of any of the illnesses that are allegedly caused by any of said purported viruses,

5. - or, wherein any test that purportedly relates to any of these alleged viruses was validated.

"Ask a Question service" at European Food Safety Authority:

There is nothing "attached". You have simply pasted an undated, unsigned note. I check all my folders regularly and found all the other messages from your address in my inbox. The only "missing" message is the response you claim was sent on March 16th.

As for your response, it is nonsensical and contradictory. You claim on the one hand that EFSA provides "*independent scientific advice on risks related to food and feed safety*", including work on Poxviridae viruses, yet at the same time confess that EFSA is "*not in a position*" to meet my challenge which is to: **provide or cite studies authored by anyone, anywhere, ever:**

- that scientifically prove or provide evidence of the existence of any alleged virus of the Poxviridae family or
- wherein the purported "genome" of any of these alleged viruses was found intact or
- that scientifically demonstrate transmission / contagion of any of the illnesses allegedly caused by any alleged Poxviridae virus or
- wherein any test that purportedly relates to any alleged Poxviridae virus was validated or
- that at least describe purification of particles claimed to be any alleged Poxviridae virus, directly from bodily fluid/tissue/excrement of so-called "hosts".

You have demonstrated that EFSA is not independent, that EFSA simply goes along with the establishment's germ/contagion rumours (which are based on falsified/ridiculous pseudoscience) and that EFSA provides unscientific advice relating to imagined particles that EFSA's Chief Scientist and entire staff cannot even show exist.

The results are vicious and devastating and based on fraud/constructive fraud.
